

The Turner County Board of Commissioners met on Tuesday, June 2, 2015 at 6:00 PM at the Turner County Agricultural Center for the monthly board meeting with Commissioners Burgess, Calhoun, Denham, Hall and McCard present for the meeting. Staff present were Mary J. Wynn, County Manager, Latrice Wilson, County Clerk and John Holland, County Attorney. Others present were Mr. and Mrs. David Smith, Remington Smith, Janet Winter, Elections Superintendent, Mrs. Jessie Youngblood, Bill Tompkins, Faye Belflower, Tammy Lassiter, Mikevion Hall, Tessa Felder, Ben Baker, Editor of the Wiregrass Farmer, Lynn Davis, Extension Coordinator, Sheriff Andy Hester and Robby Royal, EMS Director/Fire Chief.

Chairman McCard called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

Commissioner Hall gave the invocation.

Motion by Commissioner Burgess seconded by Commissioner Calhoun to adopt the agenda as printed, motion passed with Commissioners Burgess, Calhoun, Denham, Hall and McCard voting in favor of the motion.

Proclamations: Chairman McCard and Staff presented proclamations to Mikevion Hall for winning the State Championship in the Public A Long Jump Event and to Remington Smith for winning the State Championship in 4 H Air Pistol Matches.

Motion by Commissioner Burgess seconded by Commissioner Calhoun to approve financial information for April 2015 as printed, motion passed with Commissioners Burgess, Calhoun, Denham, Hall and McCard voting in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioner Burgess seconded by Commissioner Calhoun to approve the minutes of previous meetings as printed, motion passed with Commissioners Burgess, Calhoun, Denham, Hall and McCard voting in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioner Burgess seconded by Commissioner Calhoun to accept the lowest bid for janitorial cleaning services from Executive Cleaning, Inc. in the amount of \$ 18,600.00 for FY 2015-2016, motion passed with Commissioners Burgess, Calhoun, Denham and McCard voting in favor of the motion. Commissioner Hall opposed the motion. Commissioner Hall spoke stating he had concerns about the bid being to low for the job we are asking for.

Motion by Commissioner Calhoun seconded by Commissioner Denham to allow the Road Department to change to a four day 10 hours work week with the exception of holidays. If a holiday falls within that week, the department will revert back to working 8 hours a day instead of 10 hours and then take the holiday (8 hours), motion passed with Commissioners Burgess, Calhoun, Denham, Hall and McCard voting in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioner Calhoun seconded by Commissioner Burgess to table item # 3: Letter from Tim Floyd requesting Sconyers Road to be closed, motion passed with Commissioners Burgess, Calhoun, Denham, Hall and McCard voting in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioner Burgess seconded by Commissioner Calhoun to approve agreement between the Circuit Public Defender Office of the Tifton Judicial Circuit and Turner County for fiscal year 2015-2016 for public defender expenses in the amount of \$71,803.69 and

authorized the Chairman to sign agreement on behalf of the County, motion passed with Commissioners Burgess, Calhoun, Denham, Hall and McCard voting in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioner Calhoun seconded by Commissioner Burgess to approve Executive Session Minutes for March 17, 2015, motion passed with Commissioners Burgess, Calhoun, Denham, Hall and McCard voting in favor of the motion.

There were no public comments.

Motion by Commissioner Calhoun to adjourn the meeting at 6:11 P.M.
