The Turner County Board of Commissioners met on Thursday, April 23, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. at the Turner County Courthouse Annex Building for a Called "advertised" Budget Meeting with Commissioners Burgess, Calhoun, Denham, Hall and McCard present for the meeting. Staff present were Mary J. Wynn, County Manager and Latrice Wilson, County Clerk. Others present were Sheriff Andy Hester.

Chairman McCard called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Commissioner Hall gave the invocation.

Motion by Commissioner Hall seconded by Commissioner Burgess to adopt a policy given the Administrative Office the authority to settle inactive delinquent accounts at 50% of its total amount and to settle active accounts by adjusting penalty only if the amount is paid in full, motion passed with Commissioners Burgess, Calhoun, Denham, Hall and McCard voting in favor of the motion.

Commissioners discussed garbage service. Commissioners expressed their concerns about garbage pickup service for Turner County residents. Commissioners agreed to write a letter to the Solid Waste Authority expressing their concerns about these issues.

Commissioners discussed FY 2015-2016 Operating Budget. Commissioners discussed the Administrative and Superior Court proposed budgets.
