Motion by Commissioner Calhoun seconded by Commissioner Denham to accept bid from East Coast Asphalt, LLC in the amount of \$599,732.90 for 2018 Local Maintenance & Improvement Grant for resurfacing improvements to Son Story Road, Coley Street, Byrd Street, Amelia Avenue, East Inaha Road, Carter Road and High Hill Road, motion passed with Calhoun, Denham, Hall and McCard voting in favor of the motion.

Mr. Jason Anderson and Mr. Ray Jordan of ABM Building Solutions presented to the Board their findings after conducting a utility study on county buildings. Commissioners agreed to allow ABM to release a request for qualifications (RFQ). This process will allow other energy service companies that are capable of providing comprehensive energy services to submit a proposal.
